How to Respond to a Dream

He speaks in dreams, in visions of the night, when deep sleep falls on people as they lie in their beds.

Job 33:15 NLV

Read Daniel 2:24-49

1. Before you seek an interpretation, make an effort to discern if it is a prophetic dream. Not every dream is a prophetic dream, a dream with a message from God.
2. Some dreams may have come from a natural occurrence. Some dreams can happen because of medicine that you take. Some dreams happen because of what you ate last night. It is not just what you eat, but when you eat it that can affect your dreams. Dining on a big meal just before turning in for the night boosts your body's temperature and metabolism—two consequences that result in more brain activity during the REM stage.
3. Prophetic dreams are usually vivid and seem very real. They are complex and contain a great deal of symbolism. They are etched into your memory.
4. Be aware that dreams can and will reveal to the interpreter things you may not want revealed.
5. Write the dream down in the journal.

6. Ask God to give YOU the interpretation first.
7. Pray after receiving the interpretation from someone else.
8. Remember, the interpreter knows in part.
For we know in part, and we prophesy in part.
1 Cor. 13:9
9. Dreams come to warn us, to comfort us, to guide us and to open doors to emotional healing, etc. Dreams bring announcements of next seasons, new births, etc.
10. If you sense that the dream is a warning, pray until you believe God has released you from the burden. Find the scripture that answers the problem in the dream and declare those scriptures out loud until you feel a release to stop.
11. Dreams are not usually literal. Seek understanding of the symbols in the dream.
12. If a dream indicates a large life change, seek counsel from a senior leader that you trust.
13. Interpret the dream within the overall context of the emotion you felt upon waking. In the journal there is space to write down what you feel.
14. If you are uncomfortable with the interpretation of your dream, write it down and ask God to reveal more about the dream to you. "Put it on the shelf." If the interpretation is true, God will bring it back to you. However, do not dismiss what could be a warning to you and your family.
15. NO MATTER WHAT, the Word of God takes preeminence over the interpretation and your feelings.
